## Introduction

Among its activities in accordance with the founding charter, the CAAC develops the following actions:

- Cooperation Projects

## Composition of the Scientific Council

The Scientific Committee is composed, as far as possible, by 6 members. So to the extent possible, these positions will be shared on a sectoral basis (5 members of Atlantic Universities, one of the corresponding CAAC Commission) and geographical (the five countries of the Atlantic Arc should be represented).

## Conditions of the post

1. This is a volunteer and part-time position for two years, for the period 2012-2013;
2. The Scientific Council should imperatively enjoy the trust of the Executive Bureau and the General Assembly of the CAAC, in this regard it will meet at least once a year at the GA.
3. The (the) applicant (s) must indicate their availability when submitting his candidacy;
4. The nature of job requires some availability to share with CAAC staff and Executive Bureau
